Occurrence

Atopic dermatitis affects 17% of children and 2-10% of adults in Hungary (1, 2). In 80% of eczema cases, the onset is in the first 5 years of life (1). 60-70% of patients "outgrow" the disease by the age of 20 (1).

It tends to "persist" from childhood into adulthood positive family history (eczema in close relatives), early onset of disease, severe childhood clinical presentation, photosensitive, fair skin type (1).

LOCALIZATION

The first symptoms may start in infancy, at 2-3 months. In infants, the hairy scalp and forehead and face are typically affected (1,3).

In the childhood form, the limbs and trunk are also affected. Typical sites are the flexor surfaces: elbow, hand, knee, ankle, as well as the back of the head, the sole of the foot and the hands (1).

In adulthood, the symptoms are usually milder than in childhood, affecting the hairline, neck, face, hands and feet (1).
